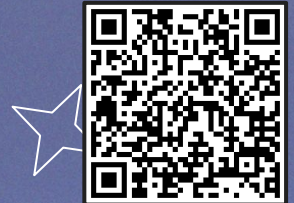

We strive to educate each other on medical, cultural, social and political issues, application processes, and ultimately create a supportive environment that builds our members up to become sensitive and productive healthcare providers

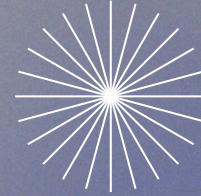

CHE During The Pandemic

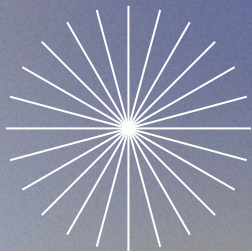
Lack of Engagement

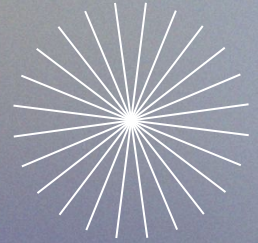


Picnic Day 2023!

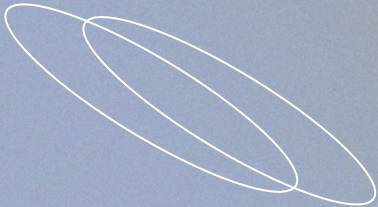
